Listed Buildings Threatened by Applications to Demolish In 2007

(The Ancient Monuments Society is a mandatory consultee on applications to demolish listed buildings in whole or part in England and Wales.)

These statistics cover England and Wales but not Scotland or Northern Ireland.

The total number of listed buildings subject to applications to demolish was 108.

The total number of listed buildings subject to applications to demolish in Wales was 6.

Each entry takes the following format:

- i) Town / County as applicable.
- ii) Name and address of building.
- iii) The grade of listing is given: I, II* or II.
- iv) The month in which the AMS was informed of the application.
- v) The date of the building if known.

Then the code indicates:

C - Application submitted by Council

CC -Application submitted by County Council

F -Application wholly or partly prompted by fire damage.

R - Building threatened by a road scheme

Rp -Proposal for "replica" Facade after development.

These figures include applications for delisting where the building has been demolished.

The name of the local authority is given in parenthesis if it is not clear.

Finally the result of the application, if yet determined, is given.

Terrace r/o 21-22 Wrawby St, Grammar School Lane; (N Lincs) Lane; II(3); Dec; mid C18; applic to delist - unroofed.

Gwent Steam Power House, r/o Church St; II; C19; Sep.

247 Brixton Rd, SW9; II; Jan; c1840; mostly demolished; applic to delist.

BUCKINGHAM

Castle House, West St; II; March; resite various C18 statues from grounds to Stowe Gardens.

Knights Farm; II; May; late C18; F; Yes. (West Berks)

BURTON-ON-TRENT, Staffs.

Ale House, The Maltings, Wetmore Rd; II; Jan; C19. (E. Staffs)

1. 5 St Martin's Way; II; C18; June.
2. C19 wing, Boughton Hall, Filkins Lane; II; July

The Granary, Barford Park Farm; C18; March. (Salisbury)

Oakwood; II; Jan; late C16; move to new site further (Herefordshire) north.

60 Wath Rd (Station Row); II; late C18; Nov. Rp. (Barnsley)

ELSWICK, Lancs.

Barn, Chapel Farm, Copp Lane; II; Dec; with crucks; (Fylde) rebuild in Rp.

Old Rectory, Church Hill; II; C18 + C19; Dec; applic delist after F.

FARTHINGHOE, Northants.

Barn, N of The Limes, Main Rd; C18 + C16 door; (S. Northants) demolish roof and most of shell.

1. Greensfield Railway Station, Hudson St; II; Jan; 1844; delist as has been demolished.
2. Half Moon Hotel, Half Moon Lane; II; C19; Sep.

“Platoff”, Platoff Rd; II; Sep; F; delist; Yes. (New Forest)

MANCHESTER

“Old Thatch”. Manchester Airport; II; threatened by airport expansion : much abused vernacular

MILLAND, Sussex 11 Milland Lane; II; mid C18; Dec; withdrawn. (Chichester)

NAILSWORTH, Glos.

Drinking fountain, Market St; II; 1862; July; reerect (Stroud) elsewhere in town.

NAUNTON BEAUCHAMP, Worcs. (Wychavon)

Cider Barn, Naunton Court; II; timber frame; reconstruct.

NEWTON, Cambs.

Forge, 58 Town St; II (curtilage); mid C19; May; (S. Cambs)

NORWICH, Norfolk

Holme Cottages, The Great Hospital, Bishopsgate; curtilage of I; C1910; April.
